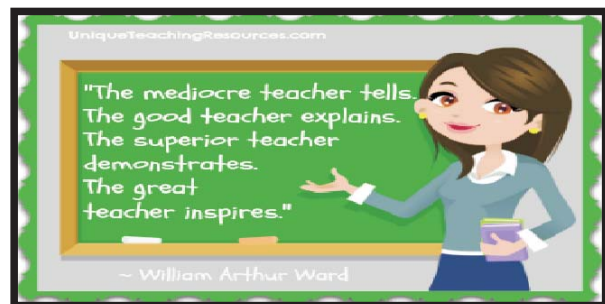
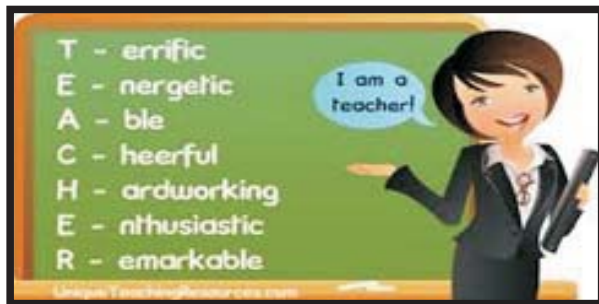

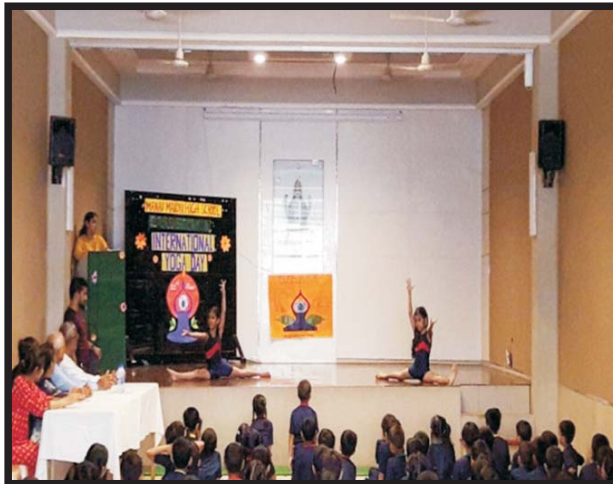


DATE: 14.6.18 :ENGLISH SLOGAN WRITING COMPETITION:-

Summer day: Children played with sand and learnt about texture, wet and dry sand.

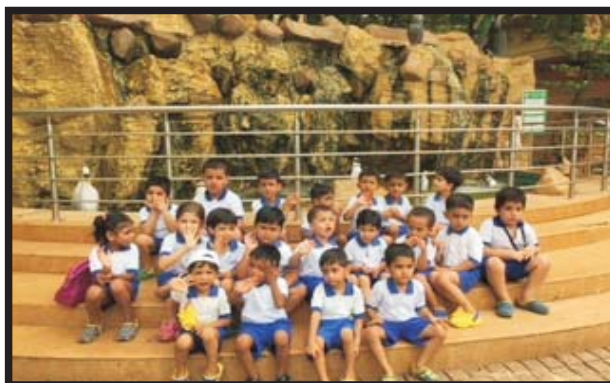


DATE: 27/04/2018 BEACH DAY: WATER PLAY
